2021 Organisation and Class Placements

During Term 4, we spend a great deal of time planning the class structures, staffing and class allocations for the next year. To do this accurately we need to know about children who may not have enrolled to begin Kindergarten, or more importantly, anyone who is leaving for another school. It is essential that we have written advice if your child will be starting late next year or if your family is moving. If your family will not be at school for the start of the school year we need to be supplied with a letter explaining the absence and clearly stating your intended return date. Without this we are not able to include your child when formulating classes and this greatly impacts on the start of the year. Please contact the school office on 9790 6176 or email the school to let us know as soon as possible.

As you may have heard in the media there will now be two Staff Development Days in Term 1 2021 instead of the usual two at the end of the year in Term 4. **This means that students in Year 1 and Year 2 will return to school on Friday 29th January 2021.** Wednesday 27th and Thursday 28th will be Staff Development Days. Kindergarten will begin on Monday 1st February 2021. Preschool and Early Intervention will have a staggered start and parents will be informed individually of their start date. Next year we will return into holding classes until numbers are confirmed. Once our numbers are confirmed we will form classes and announce teachers.

2021 School Uniform

Thank you to all of the families who have made sure their children are wearing the correct school uniform this year. Our students look wonderful and feel such a sense of school and personal pride when they know they are wearing what is required.

All students K-2 are expected to wear full school uniform each day which includes plain black school shoes and white socks Monday to Thursday. Sports shoes and white socks need to be worn on a Friday.

Correct school uniform also means not adding non-uniform items including: brightly coloured shoe laces and hair ribbons (all hair accessories need to be royal blue and yellow); jewellery, clothing which is visible and worn underneath the uniform, such as long sleeves under short sleeves and leggings/tights; non-uniform jackets, gloves, scarves, hats, jumpers and jackets.

One way in which we can foster school pride and build our reputation in the community is by the wearing of correct school uniform every day. We greatly appreciate your support.

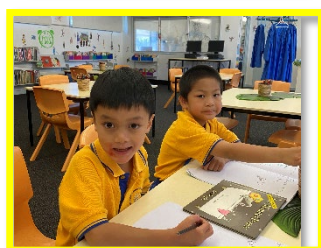

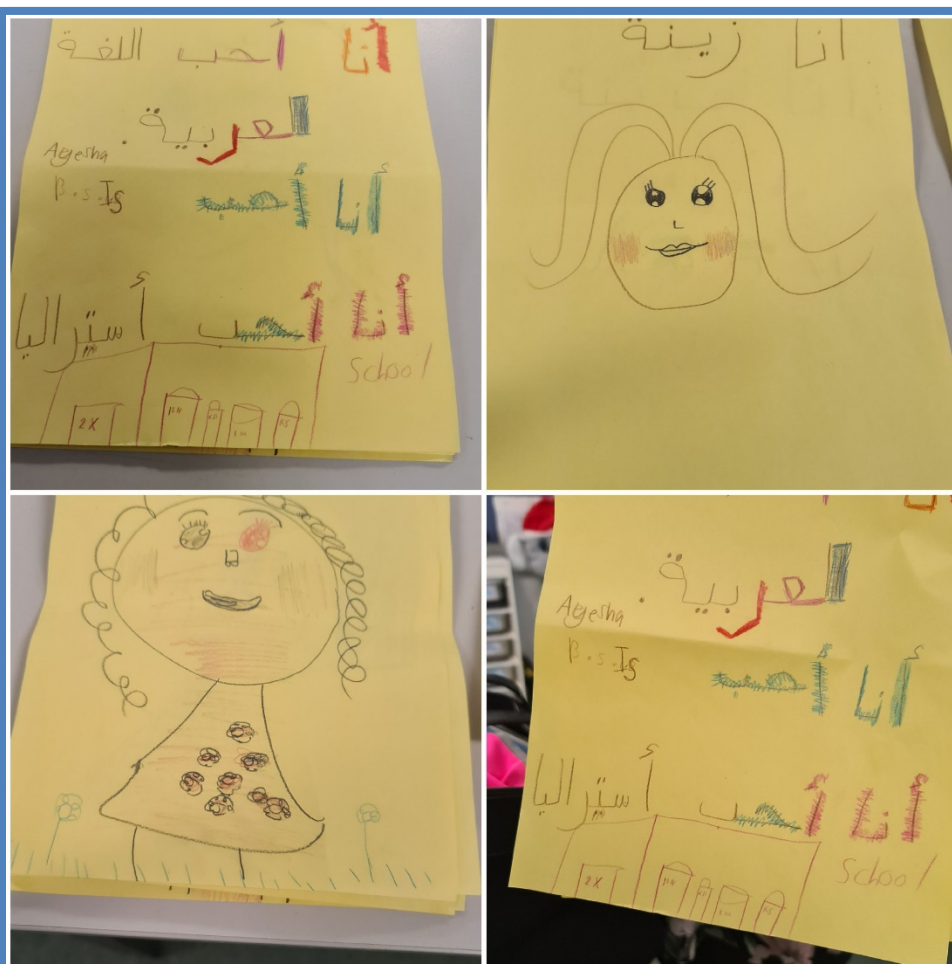


Arabic

School Travel for 2021



2021 school travel applications are now open

Applications for student travel in 2021 opened from Monday 12 October 2020.

Students who require a School Opal card or travel pass for 2021 can now [apply](#) online. A new application should be submitted if a student is applying for a school travel pass for the first time or requesting an additional pass as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody).

Students who have changed school/campus, changed address, repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should [re-apply or update their details](#).

*Applications must be completed by the student's parent or legal guardian if the student is aged under 16 years. Students 16 years and over must complete the application form themselves.

Where there is a change of distance eligibility based on a student's grade, the system will automatically update a student's entitlement if they meet the new criteria. If they do not meet the new [eligibility criteria](#), they will receive an expiry notification via email.

Students who have an entitlement approved under a medical condition which is due to expire will receive a notification advising them to re-apply.

[Term Bus Pass](#) holders will receive a notification to re-apply.

If a student needs to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to <https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails>

Applications need to be submitted before **31 December 2020** to ensure that current student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card remains valid. If their application is submitted after 31 December 2020, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.

Students in the Opal network applying for a SSTS or Term Bus Pass entitlement for the first time will receive their card at their nominated postal address. Cards will be mailed out from January 2021.

Students residing in Rural and Regional (R&R) areas should receive their travel pass at the commencement of the new school year from their nominated operator, this may be distributed via the school or sent direct to their address. **Note:** some R&R operators do not issue travel passes. Students/Parents should confirm with their nominated operator if they do not receive a pass.

New Concession Entitlement Cards

Transport for NSW will be replacing the below cards with Transport Concession Entitlement Cards (TCEC) from October 2020:

- Senior Secondary Student Concession Card (16 years and over) – also used by Mature Secondary Students (18 years and over), Distance Education Students and Home School Students
- Proof of Age card (when a student under 16 years of age looks older) □
Boarder Rail Pass.

All previous cards will be valid until they expire. Students who require a Transport Concession Entitlement Card should speak with their school administration staff.

Getting On Track In Time – Got It!

What is the Got It! program?

Getting on Track in Time! – *Got It!* is an early intervention mental health program provided by local health professionals from your Local Health District in partnership with the Department of Education. The *Got It!* team from South Western Sydney Local Health District will begin working with your child's in Term **{Insert Term & Year}**.

The program aims to address behavioural and emotional difficulties in children in Kindergarten – Year 2, aged 5-8 years old. When disruptive behaviours occur regularly they can negatively influence children's academic, emotional and social development. Children will display problem behaviours as a normal part of development because they do not yet have the social, emotional and problem solving skills to manage new challenges.

Got It! builds emotional resilience and enhances the development of social skills in young children that will support them to better manage their emotions and behaviours at school and at home. This assists them to learn to their full potential and maximise their life opportunities. The program is fun and supportive for students and provides practical help to parents and teachers

I have been working in Children's Services for over the last ten years and have had many roles within my years of working in the field. I have a Certificate III in Children Services, Certificate IV in Out Of School Hours Care and a Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care.

I am beyond excited to be starting my new journey at Bankstown South SMOOSH and building a connection with the children, families, the school and community. I'm excited to explore, learn and have fun! But also "Becoming, Belonging and Being "as one.

About SMOOSH at Bankstown South Infants School:

Location: SMOOSH is in the school grounds and we are located in the school hall located near the school canteen.

Operating Hours: Before School Care 7:00am to 9:00am (opening from the 16th of November 2020) and After School Care 2:45pm to 6:00pm.

Vacation Care: Operates at Bankstown Public School from 7:00am to 6:00pm – All children from ages 5 to 13 years old are welcome to join our fun filled program ranging from in centre activities, incursions and excursions. Breakfast is supplied. Children will need to bring morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea, drink bottle, hat and bag.

SMOOSH Menu: SMOOSH offers a range of food on our delicious menu. We have a breakfast club in the morning from 7:30am to 8:00am, afternoon tea from 3:30pm to 4:00pm and late snack from 5:00pm. Children and family suggestions are implemented into our food menu and our SMOOSH menu is reflected on the "Australian Guide To Healthy Eating". At SMOOSH we also cater to all dietary needs. We have a different menu implemented every two weeks so that children are getting different, nutritious, healthy food.

SMOOSH Program: SMOOSH before and after school care programs are committed to high quality care for each and every child, including those with additional needs. Care is provided in a safe, relaxed environment that nurtures creativity, social skills, life skills and physical activity appropriate for middle childhood. The educational programs take a holistic approach to your child's development, extending their competencies and skills, to enhance their learning and help them progress with confidence. Our programs are also recreation-based. We partner with children and families to plan activities, menus and inclusive experiences that support children's interests and needs. A collaborative learning community is encouraged by promoting opportunities for children to explore, discover and create.


