Preschool Koalas



This week the children helped to clean the Australian environment as we prepare for Clean Up Australia Day. We discussed the effect rubbish has on our wildlife and discussed the Australian animal names. Many of the children only knew crocodile, kangaroo and koala so we will investigate our native animals more closely in the coming weeks.

For our clean up day during the rain breaks we cleaned out the sandpit to prepare for our new sand delivery. Look at our beautiful fresh new sand.



We love giving the children a voice to vote on their preferred story. After they have voted we then count and graph our findings to see the winning story.





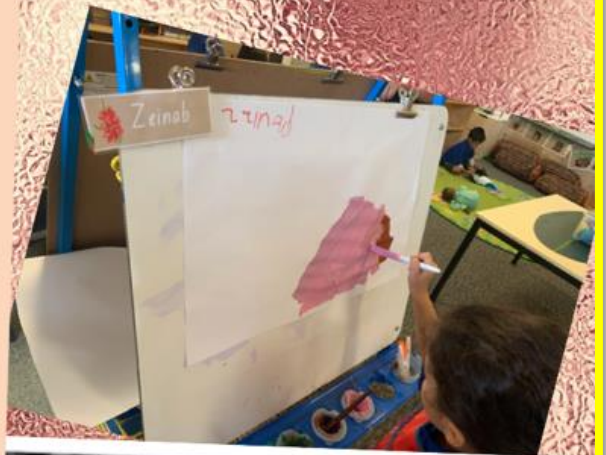
Early mathematics with the children using dice and recognising dot patterns. Children then had to find the corresponding number to trace.

Name writing with the children every day has started and for some it may take all year to learn.

A developing 5 year old hand looks very different to a 7 year old. Hand strength is built up through play and hand manipulation activities.

When the children begin we encourage correct pencil grip but do not force it. A developing hand can not be made to make movements it is not ready for yet. We just help the children track the lines.

Once the children are confident enough not to be guided they have a go by themselves on all their work.

An example of a hand manipulation activity you can do at home. The children squeeze the ball with one hand and feed the ball with their other. In this hand encourage the children to pick up a few pieces at a time to feed the ball so that it creates in-hand manipulation when they move the pieces around in their hand to their pincer fingers.

Early Intervention

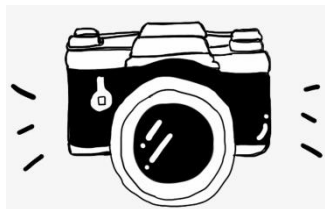
Early Intervention

Child restraint rules

Children under the age of seven years must be restrained in an age-appropriate child restraint or booster seat, when traveling in a vehicle. Always make sure your children are buckled-up before driving off.
Minimum penalty \$349 and three demerit points.

Drive vehicle using a mobile phone in school zone

Minimum penalty \$464 and five demerit points.



Obeys the school zone speed limit of 40 km/h during school terms.

**Driving safely in & around school zones****'No Stopping' signs**

Drivers must not stop in an area where a 'No Stopping' sign applies.
Minimum penalty \$349 and two demerit points.

**Stopping on or near a:**

• Pedestrian crossing;
• Children's crossing; and
• Marked foot crossing.
Minimum penalty \$464 and two demerit points.

**Double parking**

Double parking is illegal and dangerous.
Minimum penalty \$349 and two demerit points.

**Making an illegal u-turn**

Minimum penalty \$349 and three demerit points.

**'No Parking' signs**

Drivers must not stop unless dropping-off or picking-up passengers. The maximum stopping time is two minutes. The driver must stay within three metres of the vehicle.
Minimum penalty \$194 and two demerit points.

**'Bus Zone' signs**

Drivers must not stop or park in a bus zone unless you are driving a public bus.
Minimum penalty \$349 and two demerit points.
